1) A Girl who gets photographed daily:

- An Indian origin girl has a photograph for every single special moment of her life starting from the ultrasound scan to her 18th birthday.

- Her accountant father Munish Bansal, who lives in Kent, UK has been clicking his daughter's pictures every day since she was born on May 16,1996.
- The accountant said that he just wanted to see how the memories change day to day and he wanted to observe it closely.
- So he has clicked everyday of her life.

2) World's largest flower Bouquet is 59 feet tall:

The world's largest flower bouquet has been built in Beijing, China. Enormous artificial flowers were used for the bouquet. The bouquet was built for China's National Day and is a whopping 59 feet tall, with a diameter of 49 feet.

3) Giant Rugby ball built from 19,205 Bottle-Caps:

New Zealand based, Alastair Galpin, who is officially recognized as the decade's second biggest Guinness World Record holder, has created an impressive metal rugby ball using a kilometer of wire and 19,205 used bottle caps. Galpin already holds 38 official Guinness World Records. His 7*5.2 feet ball took 18 months to build.

4) 98-Foot-Tall World's Largest Crossword Puzzle:

- Explore the historical city of Lviv, Ukraine by solving this huge crossword puzzle.
- Imprinted on the side of a 98 feet tall apartment building, the world's biggest crossword puzzle consists of 19 squares across and 34 squares in height.
- With around 80 clues scattered across the city, it takes as much brain power to complete the crossword puzzle.
- The clues are hidden in major landmarks where visitors can learn more about the city's history.

5) Highest Railway Track is at an Altitude of 13,000 Feet:

- Located at 13,000 feet above the sea level, 'Train to the Clouds' is one of the highest railways in the world.
- It begins its journey from the city of Salta in Argentina from altitude of 3894 feet and further it rises to a staggering 13,000 feet.
- This train's name comes from the numerous clouds that are often seen under the bridges.
- The train travels 217 kms.
